FINAL DEFAULT JUDGMENT

THIS CAUSE came before the Court on a Motion for Entry of a Final Default Judgment requesting a declaration that is certain written defamation published in a digital format (Digital Defamation) within the State of Florida be declared defamatory. This Judgment is entered on the sole issue as to whether such Digital Defamation is defamatory.

The Court being duly advised in the premises, it is hereby declared that:

1. On April 4, 2021, Plaintiff filed its Complaint against John Doe 1. The Plaintiff verified the Complaint and stated that all of the factual recitations contained therein were true and accurate.
2. On April 17, 2021, the Plaintiff gave notice in the Tallahassee Advertiser of this Action. The notice ran for thirty (30) days.
3. The Defendant has received constructive notice and has been constructively served pursuant to Florida Statutes 49.011(5) and 49.21 and has not defended this action. Constructive service is proper under Florida Statutes 49.011(5) and 49.21.

4. The Court finds that the Plaintiff has been unable to effectuate *in personam* service based upon the Defendant John Doe 1 concealing his name and address as reflected in the Affidavit of Diligent Search.

5. Although this is not a case wherein the Plaintiff relies upon the Florida long-arm statute (Florida Statute 48.193(1) and merely seeks *in rem* or *quasi in rem* jurisdiction over Digital Defamation published in Florida, the Court finds that Defendant John Doe 1 has satisfied the minimum contact requirements with the State of Florida as set forth in *Shaffer v. Heitner*, 433 U.S. 186 (1977) (wherein the United States Supreme Court found that *in rem* jurisdiction, *quasi* and *in rem* jurisdiction and *in personam* jurisdiction require an analysis of the minimum contact standards elucidated in *International Shoe Co. v. Washington*, 326 U.S. 310, 316 (1945). See also *Caiazza dba The Beatles Autographs v. American Royal Arts Corp.*, 70 So. 3d 245 (Fla. 4th DCA 2011) and *Internet Solutions v Marshall*, 39 So. 3d 1201 (Fla. 2010) (posting of defamatory material continually accessible on Google.com in Florida constitutes a tortious act in Florida sufficient to satisfy the minimum contact standards of *International Shoe Co.*, *supra*). See also *Wendt v. Horowitz*, 822 So. 2d 1252 (Fla. 2002); *Bedford Computer Corp. v. Graphic Press, Inc.*, 484 So. 2d 225 (Fla. 1986); *Zeiman v. Costa*, 578 So. 2d 332 (Fla. 3d DCA 1991) and *Meiliunas v. O'Leary*, 483 So. 2d 509, 510 (Fla. 4th DCA 1986) (*in rem* or *quasi in rem* jurisdiction pursuant to constructive service is only allowable when a Plaintiff does not seek money damages, thus no Fourteenth Amendment substantive due process rights arising from a money judgment are implicated). See also *Hugenor v. Hugenor*, 420 So. 2d 344 (Fla. 5th DCA 1982).

6. The Court finds that applying the cases set forth in paragraph five above, the Defendant John Doe 1's conduct in connection with the State of Florida are such that the Defendant could reasonably anticipate being "hauled into Court" in Florida and "do not offend traditional

notions of fair play and substantial justice". See *Execu-Tech Bus. Sys., Inc. v. New Oji Paper Co.*, 752 So. 2d 582, 584 (Fla. 2000) (quoting *International Shoe Co. v. supra* at 316 and *World-Wide Volkswagen Corp. v. Woodsen*, 444 U.S. 286, 297 (Fla. 1980).

7. The Plaintiff is requesting that the Court enter an Order construing the Digital Defamation as defamatory in its format as a written instrument. The Court finds that this is an *in rem* or *quasi in rem* request for jurisdiction. As a result of the Defendant's choice to not defend this lawsuit and to conceal his true identity and whereabouts thus avoiding *in personam* jurisdiction, the Clerk of Court entered a Clerk's default on May 15, 2021.

8. The Court finds that the Plaintiff could not obtain *in personam* jurisdiction by service of process over Defendant John Doe 1, through no fault of the Plaintiff.

9. The Court finds that the Plaintiff's Affidavit of Diligent Search contained in the Court file is sufficient to establish the Plaintiff's inability to perfect service of process and *in personam* jurisdiction.

10. The Court finds that the Plaintiff properly published constructive notice pursuant to Florida Statute 49 as evidenced by the Proof of Publication contained in the Court file.

11. The Court finds that the Plaintiff has set forth a *prima facie* case that the Digital Defamation is, in fact, defamatory and false.

12. The Court finds that the Defendant John Doe 1's speech is not otherwise protected by the First Amendment.

13. The Court finds that the Defendant's Fourteenth Amendment, substantive due process rights, are not implicated and that the Plaintiff seeks only Declaratory Judgment and no award of costs and no request for supplemental relief.

14. The Court also rules that this Declaratory Judgment shall not be deemed *res judicata* or have any preclusive effect in the event that the identity of Defendant John Doe 1 is later determined and the Plaintiff brings a claim for damages, i.e., this Judgment will not preclude Defendant John Doe 1 from defending a damage claim on the merits at a later date in the future.

15. The Court finds that the venue is proper in Leon County in that the Digital Defamation was published in Leon County and therefore under Florida Statute 770.05 had this claim be brought in defamation as opposed to a request for a Declaratory Judgment, venue would be proper in Leon County.

16. The Court orders that the Defendant shall remove the Digital Defamation contained at <http://www.gripeo.com/vito-glazers/>, a written copy which is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.


17. That if the Defendant cannot in fact be located and cannot request that the Digital Defamation be removed or cannot remove the Digital Defamation from the Internet, the Plaintiff can submit this Order to Google, Yahoo, Bing, or any other Internet search engine so that the link can be removed from their search results pursuant to their existing policies concerning de-indexing of defamatory material;

18. That the Plaintiff has sought no monetary damages, costs, or supplemental relief against the Defendant in this Declaratory Action and this Judgment merely a declaration that the Digital Defamation is defamatory pursuant to Florida Statute 86.

19. The Court orders that if the name and address of the Defendant is in fact determined at a later date, the Plaintiff shall serve by service of process upon the Defendant.

20. That the Defendant or the Plaintiff may submit this Order to Google, Yahoo, Bing or any other Internet search engine to have the Digital Defamation removed from that search engine's search results. The Plaintiff is free to submit this Order to any Internet Service Provider to cause such defamation to be removed or otherwise de-indexed at any time now or in the future.

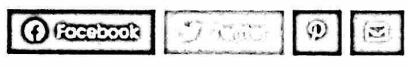

If you'd read several PR articles on Vito Glazers, you'd think he is a heaven-sent. But if you'd read the reviews from his affiliates, you'd see a vastly different picture.

Vito Glazers has a sketchy past and his current ventures indicate that he's upto no good.

In the following points, I'll illustrate why you should be wary of Vito Glazers and his company, Glazers Media. But first, let me introduce the guy for those who don't know him:

Vito Glazers Wikipedia: A Little About the Scammer

There's no Vito Glazers Wikipedia page, but there's a bio page on his personal website. According to that, Vito Glazers is the CEO of One World Publishing. He claims to be a performance marketing pioneer.

Vito is a real estate investor, actor, and media entrepreneur. His bio fails to mention that he used to run CPATank, an affiliate marketing company notorious for running a text-messaging scam.

Vito has appeared on "Mystery Millionaire" and has co-starred in the Chop Chop TV Show. Currently, he sells influencer marketing courses and PR services through his company, Glazers Media.

Vito Glazers' blo doesn't mention anything about how he lied in the court to defraud the Federal Trading Commission. It also fails to tell you anything about the conflicts he had with his affiliates because he didn't pay them.

It's vital to know about this information because Vito sells numerous products that cost tens of thousands of dollars. You should know what kind of a guy you're purchasing from, when you spend that kind of money.

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5. Is Vito Glazers Legit?





If you're interested in finding out about Vito Glazers wife, then I must say, there isn't any information available online. Still, you can look up Vito Glazers wife yourself.

But in the next few sections of this article, I'll go through some of the things Vito has tried to hide from you:

Vito Glazers Net Worth: He is NOT a Millionaire

According to the guy himself, Vito Glazers net worth is not in millions. So, according to Vito, he is *not* a millionaire.

In 2014, the Federal Trade Commission had sued Vito Glazers and his firm (CPATank) for being involved in a scam. The court had imposed a \$200,000 judgement against him and he filed a sworn financial statement that said he can't pay more than \$20,000.

And this was right before he appeared in "Mystery Millionaire".

Doesn't make sense, right? If Vito was a millionaire, why would his sworn financial statement say he couldn't even pay \$20,000? Vito Glazers either lied about his net worth on TV or he lied to the court.

A participant on a reality dating show who doesn't tell the truth? So what's new. A participant on a reality dating show who is a defendant in an FTC action and doesn't tell the truth in a sworn financial statement? That's a different story.

In 2014 the FTC sued Vito Glazers and his company, CPATank, for their role in a massive spam text message operation deceptively pitching websites offering "free" prizes and gift cards. Consumers got texts that said things like "Dear Walmart shopper, your purchase last month won a \$1000 gift card, go to [website] within 24 hours to claim." Most consumers ended up with zilch. One of the only "winners" was Vito Glazers, who served as an intermediary between the companies running those sites and networks of affiliate marketers who touted the bogus offers to unsuspecting consumers.

In addition to broad injunctive relief, the order in that case imposed a \$200,000 judgment against Glazers. He filed a sworn financial statement that purported to show he couldn't pay more than \$20,000. Among other things, the



excess of \$5,000 within the past five years. He revealed only one: \$15,000 to "Sally Mae [sic]" for "Ex-girlfriend, Paid off Car."

Turns out, he was lying to the court.

Vito Glazers net worth wasn't a million at the time. But it wasn't less than \$20,000 either.

The FTC alleged that Vito's financial statement was incomplete, inaccurate, and untruthful.

They revealed to the court that Vito had set up a separate company that held his assets, called Solomon Assets LLC. Solomon Assets had received \$524,388 via wire transfer in 2012. Moreover, Vito had withdrawn \$400,000 in June 2012.

To defraud the FTC, Vito had authorized the remaining funds be paid via cashier's check to Solomon Assets. By using this evidence, FTC proved that Vito Glazers had lied about his poverty.

The court had ordered Glazers to pay \$180,000 to the FTC to settle the case. What's ironic is Vito was set to appear on Mystery Millionaire at the time where he would act broke for a couple of dates and then reveal to his date that he's a millionaire.

I guess he was rehearsing with the FTC for the show.

More details about the case:

Vito Glazers was running a spam text message operation through his company CPATank. The text messages would pitch websites that offered free gift cards and prizes.

The text said things like "Dear shopper, your last month purchase won a \$1000 gift card, go to <site name> within the next 24 hours to claim your reward." Many people fell for this scam. Vito was one of the few "winners" who was acting as an intermediary between the affiliate marketers running these fake offers and the companies who owned these sites.

Vito Glazer's company CPATank and Eagle Web Assets would promote the websites with false offers through their affiliate marketers. The affiliates received payments on the basis of the number of people who clicked their "promoted links".

The only people who weren't making any money were the consumers who were

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promised a \$1,000 reward. When they visited the link and signed up, they discovered that they had to go through a long list of steps.

The websites required them to apply for credit cards, enroll in negative option plans, and in most cases, pay a significant fee to be eligible for the so-called free rewards.

To protect consumers from such scams, the court barred Vito Glazers and Ryan Eagle from making any misrepresentations in the marketing of any product, including false "free" claims.

The court also required them to disclose all the terms and conditions of their offers.

In short, Vito Glazers has a history of scamming people. This suggests his latest ventures could be a scam too.

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VITO GLAZERS HAD TO PAY \$180,000 TO THE COURT FOR RUNNING A SPAM TEXT MESSAGING SCAM IN 2014. HE HAD LIED ABOUT HIS NET WORTH IN THE COURT.

Vito Glazers: A History of Scamming People

Now that you know the truth about Vito Glazers net worth 2020, you should know a bit more about his past.

Evidence suggests that Vito has a long history of scamming people. Although he has buried a lot of information on the internet, there are still some traces left.

I found a thread on digitalgangster.com about CPATank, Vito's last venture. In CPATank, Vito used to pay affiliates for bringing traffic to his traffic websites. And it seems that he used to scam the affiliates just like he scammed the innocent consumers.

This person had talked to Vito when they joined the CPATank affiliate network:

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vito (3:55:20 AM): your traffic is good
(3:55:22 AM): Oh
vito (3:55:29 AM): in fact we can add 15 to the payout'
(3:55:33 AM): nice
vito (3:55:39 AM): I add it for you now

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l... (3:53:44 AM): Oh cool

bc... (3:56:23 AM): I have access to 5million uniques a month, wanted to try a beats by dre ad but the offer wasn't converting after 600+ clicks

vito (3:57:28 AM): ok let me get you a beats by dre that works better

vito (3:58:10 AM): 4675 - Submit - Free Beats Headphones by Dr Dre

vito (3:58:15 AM): that beats by dre will do very good for you

bc... (3:58:21 AM): ty

vito (3:58:26 AM): i thank you!

vito (4:06:38 AM): let me know if you need anything else to start

bc... (4:06:48 AM): ya

vito (4:06:51 AM): and if you need weekly pay etc

vito (4:07:10 AM): whatever, it's no problem just stick to email submits for this type of traffic and ask me if you have any doubts

bc... (4:07:17 AM): is it possible to be paid tomorrow with everyone else? Account has had my tax form and everything

vito (4:07:26 AM): payments aren't going out tomorrow

t... (4:07:37 AM): well whenever the next day is

vito (4:07:39 AM): are you sure they have everything they need?

bc... (4:07:47 AM): Yeah they emailed me case

vito (4:08:08 AM): next day is either wednesday, or next tuesday

vito (4:08:13 AM): I see if she can send your payment wednesday

vito (4:08:26 AM): it might be too late this week, if it is, ill make sure it gets sent tuesday

vito (4:08:36 AM): all balance up to \$31 will go out tuesday the 4th

vito (4:08:41 AM): then we can do weekly from there

bc... (4:08:45 AM): Okay

bc... (4:08:53 AM): Sounds good ty

vito (4:14:59 AM): thank you and stay in touch

ba... (4:41:57 AM): Do you know what has to happen for the

bc... (4:42:02 AM): Offer to convert?

bc... (4:42:11 AM): Example of my ad here www.emil.com

vito (4:44:27 AM): they just have to fill out offer in path

vito (4:44:32 AM): nice placement bro!

bc... (4:44:52 AM): So its not on email submit? They have to complete one of the offers?

vito (4:48:31 AM): yes but it's same as macbook offer

vito (4:48:39 AM): all the Email Submit offers convert like this

bc... (4:49:21 AM): Okay, if i dont get a convert after 600 clicks should i take it down?

vito (4:51:39 AM): bro if you dont get one after about 100 clicks i'd say take it down

vito (4:51:51 AM): but idk why you wouldn't, i know this offer converts good on converted tracking

vito (4:51:58 AM): if not, just switch back to macbook that was doing ok

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But when they requested payment for bringing traffic to CPATank's target websites, Vito Glazers started avoiding him.

Vito owed them \$790.30 but didn't pay a penny. They tried to contact Vito multiple times but didn't get a single response. After they shared information about this incident with others, Vito's staff contacted them and said they won't pay them because "they defrauded CPATank".

In reply to this allegation, they pointed out that Vito paid them \$50 for bringing the traffic and banned them after paying them. Vito Glazier buried the existence of this news such that no one would find it easily.

The post no longer exists on Reddit, a prominent social media platform, nor does it exist on digitalgangster.com.

If you'd visit the original link to the thread, it would show a 404 error. Thankfully, I have its screenshots:

CPATANK Does Not Pay - Small \$800 Check Stolen - CPATANK Review

CPATANK - CPATANK REVIEW - DOES CPATANK PAY ON TIME? - VITO GLAZIERS

hello, it's unfortunate that I'm writing this thread. I will preface that when I actually speak to anyone from CPA tank these are really nice and helpful. The situation is that I was owed a payment 22 days ago. Was never paid, my friend was paid. Accounting told me I was ad set for weekly payments and that I was set to be paid 22 days ago.

Amount Owed: \$790.30

I'm not the biggest earner. After not getting my CPATANK check I had my power shut off. This is because I don't live with anyone that I can mooch off of and I'm a poor red neck. I logged into my server while using Gas Station wifi and started my campaigns with PEERFLY.





Ended up doing \$2700 in about 18 hours. They paid 3 days later on time. I got my power turned back on because of their quick payments.

Conversations & What I've Done To Get My Money from CPATANK

1. Emailed Accounting@CPATANK.COM - They told me I was set to be paid and weren't sure what was up.
2. Emailed Accounting@CPATANK.COM - They never responded.
3. Skyped CPATANK Account Manager Sam - She was sympathetic, told me she was emailing Vito right then. Also advised me to contact Accounting@CPATANK.COM where CGing her and Admin@CPATANK.COM (VITO GLAZERS). No response.
4. Accountant@CPATANK.COM where CGing her and Admin@CPATANK.COM (VITO GLAZERS). No response.
5. Messaged Vito on AIM - I was told it wasn't VITO, it was JOHN. Said to text VITO. I'm a broke red neck. No phone. So he said email. I emailed and never got a response.
6. Messaged Vito on AIM two days later - I was told it was JOHN again. Told me VITO GLAZERS never received my email and that VITO was busy and to email him right now. I did, no response.
7. Messaged Vito on AIM next day - I told them I was going to post a thread. Vito has signed off. Never signed back on.

Summary:

I understand you're busy Vito. That's not my problem, don't make it your affiliates problems otherwise they will just find someone who isn't so busy that they actually get paid on time.

You said I frustrated you and costed you hundreds of dollars before and I've made a bunch of accounts. What happened was I sent low quality traffic and reached \$50 and you banned me.

I messaged you and you apologized and paid me \$50. Told me to make a new account, which I did and it sat for over a year until this incident.

I just want my money. Seriously I've made close to \$900 with Peersy since this incident and you're being money right now. I am posting this because you said in my last thread that you were going to keep my money for frauding you, which never happened.

Vito Glazers' Company: Glazers Media

Vito Glazers runs Glazers Media, a company that offers PR services and offers training products. He offers a ton of products and services where the lowest price is \$5,000, which is for a product called "Instant Influencer" Formula.

His most expensive product is the "Book Building" Formula that costs \$30,000.

Apart from these products, Vito also offers influencer marketing and reputation management services through Glazers Media.

However, there are two very prominent issues with these companies.

First, they offer no refunds. Second, they have no reviews.

For products and services that cost more than \$5,000, there should be some kind of assurance of its quality. But you only get one thing: Vito Glazers' word for it.

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No Refunds:

Many online scammers (like Amazing Selling Machine) tend to bury important details deep within their terms and conditions so you couldn't find them. They know that very few people really read the T&Cs and most people would simply click on the "I Agree" button and move on.

But I'm one of those 'few people'. I wanted to know if Vito was actually a trustworthy service provider or not.

Turns out, he is not.

His company doesn't give you refunds if you pay in cash or through cryptocurrencies:

All payments made in cash and/or crypto currency are final and can not be refunded.

This means, once you have paid those people, they won't give you a refund. What if you're dissatisfied with the product's quality? They don't care. What if the product isn't worth \$10,000? They don't care.

Vito Glazers only wants your money. And once you have paid him, there's nothing you can do about it.

Seeing how shady his history has been, I wouldn't recommend spending \$10,000 or \$20,000 just to "test out" his services.

No Reviews:

Another huge red flag in Vito's services is that his products and services have zero reviews. You wouldn't find a single person saying that they were happy with his products.

This is not a good sign. Because it means people haven't bought from him.

If people were buying this service, they would be sharing their experiences online. Vito Glazers claims to be a PR and marketing expert, but I don't think he knows the importance of customer reviews.

Either that, or he is not the expert he claims himself to be.

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Now, if some Glazers Media reviews start appearing magically after this article, know that it's because of Vito's PR team.

Companies tend to do that when you call them out on their nonsense.

Is Vito Glazers Legit?

The short answer is: no.

Vito Glazers ran a country-wide text-messaging scam in 2012 and got caught. Not only that, but Vito also lied in court about his actual net worth.

He had to pay \$180,000 to the FTC because of his scam. Vito didn't even pay the affiliates that worked with him in his previous venture.

Now, he's running a PR company that has zero reviews and doesn't offer refunds to its clients.

All of this suggests that it would be best to avoid the guy. Don't risk it.

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Glazers is a charlatan

Vito Glazers is a scam artist. His text-messaging scam was caught in 2012 and he had to pay \$180,000 for it. Vito's latest venture, Glazers Media seems like another scam as it has zero reviews and offers no refunds.

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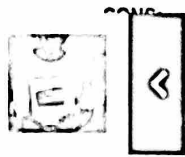
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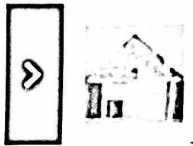

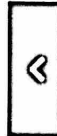
